Highlights: Upper Room Church has grown to 200+ people and we are particularly joyful over our ongoing joint Farsi conferences that draw people from all over the UK. Additionally we have had baptism services, a new partnership with Glasgow City Church through their weekly foodbank, and have persevered in developing new leaders.

New ministry initiatives:

- Weekly Bible Study Training (50+6 people in attendance)
- Weekly Women's Bible Study & Fellowship (10-12 ladies)
- Baptismal Preparation Courses (40-50 people exploring baptism)
- Monthly Film Nights through our new Evangelism Team
- Homework Club for children
- Weekly food bank support with Glasgow City Church
- Worship Team & Bible study meeting weekly
- Teen Ministry - during our weekly Thursday gathering and networking them with Render at ReHope Church.
- English Classes - weekly beginner English Classes

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

The charity experience a slight increase due to grant funding for a Homework Club and donations to fund a ministry worker. While our expenses typically are greater than our income, we trust God with our financial needs. Our community is made up primarily of refugees and with their very limited funds, they are still generous. Mainly a small committed group of donors fund our work and we are dependent on sources (e.g. grants or donations) that are not from within the fellowship. This is not concerning as we have never 'wanted' and quite frankly, money is a means to an end - it is from the Lord and given back to Him for His purposes.


